

1. Prudence (noun) : सावधानी
Meaning: the quality of being prudent; cautiousness
Synonyms: wisdom, judgment
Antonyms: folly, recklessness
2. Petulant (adjective) : धृष्टतापूर्ण
Meaning: easily angered or annoyed, esp. in a rude way
Synonyms: impatient, fractious
Antonyms: agreeable, patient
3. Complaisant (adjective) : मेहरबान
Meaning: willing to satisfy others by being polite and fitting in with their plans
Synonyms: amiable, polite
Antonyms: discontented, antagonistic
4. Relent (verb) : तरस खाना
Meaning: to cease resistance (as to another's arguments, demands, or control)
Synonyms: concede, give in
Antonyms: combat, confront
5. Pogrom (noun) : तबाही
Meaning: massacre, mass murder.
Synonyms: holocaust, slaughter
Antonyms: relief, rescue
6. Amicable (adjective) : ववन्नम्र
Meaning: characterized by friendliness and absence of discord
Synonyms: cordial, civil

- Antonyms: unfriendly, hostile
7. Purloin (verb) : चुराना
Meaning: steal (something)
Synonyms: loot, pilfer
Antonyms: bestow, contribute
8. Transient (adjective) : क्षवर्क
Meaning: lasting for only a short time; temporary
Synonyms: temporary, short-lived
Antonyms: permanent, forever
9. Invigorate (verb) : उत्तेवजत करना
Meaning: to give new energy or strength to someone or something
Synonyms: boost, stimulate
Antonyms: discourage, dissuade
10. Egalitarian (noun) : समानावधकारवादी
Meaning: one who advocates or practices social equality
Synonyms: democrat, leveler
Antonyms: snob, snoot
11. Purloin (verb) : चुराना
Meaning: steal (something)
Synonyms: loot, pilfer
Antonyms: bestow, contribute
12. Reprobate (noun) : बदमाश
Meaning: an unprincipled person
Synonyms: rogue, scoundrel
Antonyms: upright, virtuous

13. Ardent (adjective) : उत्साही

Meaning: Characterized by strong enthusiasm

Synonyms: Passionate, enthusiastic

Antonyms: apathetic, dull

14. Abominate (verb) : घृणा करना

Meaning: to hate something very much

Synonyms: abhor, despise

Antonyms: admire, approve

15. Scalding (adjective) : धधकते हुए

Meaning: If a liquid is scalding, it is extremely hot

Synonyms: blazing, blistering

Antonyms: cold, cool

16. Breviary (noun) : प्रार्थना-संग्रह

Meaning: a short statement of the main points

Synonyms: summary, conspectus, encapsulation, outline

Antonyms: enlargement, expansion

17. Stodgy (adjective) : उदासीन

Meaning: Dull and uninspired; lacking originality or excitement

Synonyms: uninteresting, dreary

Antonyms: exciting, creative

18. Pummel (verb) : कूटना

Meaning: to defeat someone easily at a sport

Synonyms: bash, batter

Antonyms: compliment, fail

19. Dilatory (adjective) : धीमा

Meaning: slow to act

Synonyms: sluggish, slothful

Antonyms: fast, prompt

20. Conflate (verb) : वमलाना

Meaning: combine (two or more sets of information, texts, ideas, etc.) into one

Synonyms: amalgamate, converge

Antonyms: divide, separate

21. Revulsion (noun) : घृणा

Meaning: a dislike so strong as to cause

stomach upset or queasiness

Synonyms: aversion, disgust

Antonyms: fondness, liking

22. Jeer (noun) : मजाक उडाना

Meaning: a rude and mocking remark

Synonyms: hoot, ridicule

Antonyms: compliment, praise

23. Precarious (adjective) : अवनवित

Meaning: dependent on chance; uncertain

24. Rebuff - दुत्कारना

verb: reject in an abrupt or ungracious manner

synonyms: reject, turn down

25. Prudent - दूरदर्शी

adjective: acting with or showing care and thought for the future

26. Mettle - उत्साह

noun : a person's ability to cope well with difficulties

27. Destitute - बेसहारा

adjective : without any money, food or a home

28. Clout - जोरदार प्रहार

noun : a hard hit, usually with the hand

29. Prejudice - पूर्वधारणा

noun: preconceived opinion that is not based on reason or actual experience

synonyms: preconceived idea, preconception

30. Couth - सुसंस्कृत

adjective: cultured, refined, and well mannered

31. Importune - वज्र करना

verb : harass someone persistently for or to do something

32. Exhort (verb) : समझाना

Meaning: Strongly encourage or urge to do

something

Synonym: enjoin, adjure

Antonym: discourage

33. Vacillate (verb): घटना बढ़ना

Meaning: Waiver between different opinions

or actions

Synonyms: temporize, hesitate

Antonyms: resolute

34. Oblige - मजबूर करना

verb : make someone bound to do something

35. Abominate (adjective) : घृणा

Meaning: to hate something very much

Synonyms: abhor, despise

Antonyms: love, like

36. Flagrant - वनन्दनीय

adjective: an action considered wrong or immoral

synonyms: blatant, glaring

37. Inviolable - अखण्ड

adjective: free or safe from injury or violation synonyms: undamaged, unhurt

noun: brisk and cheerful readiness
synonyms: eagerness, willingness

adjective : clearly expressed

46. Inextricably - अलंघनीय

adverb: in a way that is impossible to disentangle or separate

47. Counter-intuitive

adjective: contrary to common-sense expectation

48. Onslaught - हमला

noun: a very powerful attack

49. Fidelity - सत्य के प्रवत वनष्ठा

noun: faithfulness to a person, cause, or belief

synonyms: loyalty, allegiance

50. Crescendo

noun : a gradual increase in loudness

51. Recalcitrant - आज्ञा न माननेवाला

adjective: refusing to follow instructions or rules; not easy to control

52. Treason - राज-द्रोह

noun : the criminal act of causing harm to your country

53. Frugal - वकफायती

adjective: simple and plain and costing little

synonyms: meagre, scanty

54. Arduous - कविन

adjective: full of difficulties; needing a lot of effort

55. Abjure - त्यागना

verb : to promise that you will give up a way of behaving

56. Venerate - सम्मावनत करना

verb : to have and show a lot of respect

57. Dishevelled - वबखेरा हुआ

adjective : very untidy

verb: use something to maximum advantage

noun : great wealth or luxuriousness

verb : hold the complete attention of someone

adjective: based on what one feels to be true even without conscious reasoning

noun : treating a religious object or place without the respect that it deserves

verb: to laugh at something in a cruel way

adjective : annoying and irritating

adjective: happy, satisfied and without worry

synonyms: heedless, careless

78. Pejorative - हासकारी

adjective: expressing contempt or disapproval

synonyms: disparaging, derogatory

79. Rebut - गलत साबत करना

verb : claim or prove that evidence or an

accusation is false

80. Sanguine - आशावादी

adjective : cheerful, hopeful and confident

about the future

81. Undergird

verb : provide support or a firm basis for

82. Indignant - क्रोधित

adjective : shocked or angry because somebody has said or done

something

83. Broth - शोरबा

noun : a thin soup, often with vegetables or rice in it
